SYDNEY TRAINS REFORMS

Attention all Sydney Trains Members,

A Delegates Forum was held today at which Sydney Trains presented a detailed version of the current state of the Train Crew Reform proposal to RTBU Locomotive Division Representatives.

The Forum consisted of a presentation from PWC (Price Waterhouse Coopers) regarding the aggregation of the Drivers' Cab Allowance and the methodology behind their calculations.

Sydney Trains then presented the most recent iteration of their proposal consisting of the previously proposed shift limits of 8 hours and 50 minutes and 275kms.

The Loco Division continues to maintain its' position as endorsed by the membership in March of this year.

The RTBULD will be meeting with the Sydney Trains Reform Team on Thursday 15th December to provide feedback from our Delegates and continue discussions.

Members will continue to be informed as developments occur.
