Now is your chance to tell **Pacific National** that you are ready to fight and lead to secure a better Agreement.

STEP 1: Vote early!

What is a Protected Action Ballot?

A Protected Action Ballot is a fair and democratic secret ballot that gives you the right to take protected industrial action at work. Securing Protected Action means that workers can undertake the necessary actions to protect our conditions and our rights without risking our jobs. It isn't a commitment to take every action, it just gives us options. This is extremely important and why we need everyone's vote.

What to expect the following: In order to vote YES, make sure that you place a TICK or a CROSS in the 'YES' BOXES. Please ensure that you do not mark the 'NO' BOXES in any way as this may be construed as voting against taking protected industrial action.
