PN INTERMODAL MEMBERS NEWSFLASH SIGNING OFF & ON AT BARRACKS (REST LOCATION).

Members would be aware that the PN Intermodal EA provides for sign off and on to occur at the Barracks / Resting away location when working a shift which involves booking off / resting away from your home Depot.

We had been advised by a number of Delegates that this was occurring on an ad hoc basis without any consistency across PN Intermodal Depots and as such at the last few PN /RTBU consultative meetings we have raised this as something that needed to be addressed.

Members are advised that both Pacific National Management and HR have agreed with the need for a consistent approach and that the Barracks Location is the place where rest is being taken.

Agreement was also reached that when SDC call the train crew at the barracks (rest) location to sign on for the next shift, the train crew can ask SDC to sign them back on at the same time that they are being called back to work.

In both instances, the LMS Kiosk does not need to be used as SDC will manually sign you off and on.

We have been made aware that there have been instances where members felt singled out, targeted and or intimidated when they have not used the kiosk but have followed the above agreed process.

Members should not be put in a position of feeling singled out, targeted and or intimidated at work and any member/s experiencing this should contact their Local Delegate or Locomotive Division Organiser and register a formal complaint with PN HR.

This cannot be tolerated, and YOUR UNION will support any member who feels threatened and or intimidated whilst at work.
