SYDNEY TRAINS REFORMS

To All Sydney Trains Members

As members would be aware a recent Delegates Conference authorised the Division to continue the Sydney Trains Reform discussions in an effort to see if the parties could reach an outcome that could be agreed in principle (subject to another Delegates Conference and Depot meetings).

The Division has continued to meet with Sydney Trains a few days a week with Sydney Trains planning on arranging another Delegates Conference to present their more detailed proposal.

At time of writing we have not received anything of substance nor any detail on how Sydney Trains have costed their proposals, but do expect something prior to the Delegates Conference on the 13/12/2016.

Until Delegates and members have indicated their views and given feedback on Sydney Trains proposal/s the Division is unable to move from its position as endorsed by Delegates and Members earlier this year.

Whilst the discussions have been going on for some time, it needs to be emphasised from day one the Division has made it clear we will not be rushed nor will we walk away from the discussion process as any change to existing working arrangements/conditions are final and this cannot be rushed to meet Sydney Trains' self imposed timelines.

Members will continue to be informed as developments occur.
