ACTION ALERT: BAN WITHDRAWN PN NSW BULK RAIL EA 2017

Members, delegates and organisers decided to implement a protected action ban on driving locomotives where faults have not been fixed within 24 hours starting at midnight tonight.

You may have received a letter from Pacific National management today telling you that you will not be paid for your entire shift if you implement that ban.

This is a deliberate tactic by management to cause maximum confusion and to undermine your ability to act collectively to win secure jobs and fair conditions.
