AURIZON COAL ENTERPRISE AGREEMENT

Your negotiating team has met with management on 15th, 18th & 19th December, 10th & 11th, 16th & 17th, 23rd & 24th January to continue negotiations for your enterprise agreement.

The discussions have centered around the following clauses and the company and your negotiators have rigorously debate the pros & cons.

Shift Limits: **Aurizon:** align shift limits to Rail Safety Act.

RTBU: consolidate shift limits = 9hr D.O.O. & D.O.O. Shunt.

Shunting, provisioning, Roll-By, Dump Stn Door Inspector, sign on Duty between 1501 – 0459 Hours = 10hrs.

Mainline operations Dr + 2nd Person / Non Route Qualified = 11hrs

Mainline Operations Dr + Dr (route qualified) = 12hrs

Shift Change, Lift Up / Lay Back, Shift Cancellations:

Aurizon: Simplify and redraft clauses.

RTBU: Remove conflict in shift changes, stabilize the variation of sign on times in Lift up / Lay Back, Minimum of 7.6hrs to duty cycle.

Duty Cycle: **Aurizon:** 152 hr Duty Cycle

RTBU: 38 hr Duty Cycle & align to pay cycle.

Domestic Violence Leave:

Aurizon: Policy Document

RTBU: Clause included in EA.

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Intervals between Shifts:

Aurizon: 7 hours at Barracks

RTBU: keep current clause

Barracks Working:

Aurizon: Detention after 12hrs, remove 1st in / 1st off, remove 1 rest before returning home.

RTBU: Keep current and payment after 10hrs.

Work on a Rostered Day Off:

Aurizon: Remove Penalty payment if work into RDO. Pay O/T for hours worked into.

RTBU: Penalty Payment, O/T for whole shift if breached, No sign on after midday before RDO.

Definition & Interpretation:

RTBU: Tabled a clause to clearly define and explain the intention of the clause.

Your negotiating team is committed to keep you up to date on the progress of negotiations. Once there is more to report, a depot tour will commence to update members and get feedback.
